2023-2024 GRANT AWARDS

The Sisters of St. Joseph Healthcare Foundation is a non-profit, public benefit corporation which addresses the needs of the working and indigent poor in: Southern California, the San Francisco Bay Area, and Humboldt County.

PRIORITIES: The Sisters of St. Joseph Healthcare Foundation's current priorities are Housing Security, Food Security, and Family Violence Prevention, with a focused population on families with children who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness.

AWARDS: The Healthcare Foundation awarded **\$2,100,000** in grants to 57 organizations in June 2024. Grants funded for current priorities included: **\$1,250,000** for housing security

\$620,000 for food security

\$230,000 for family violence prevention.

In addition, four grants for family violence prevention were funded in June 2023 for two years.
